The story of Krondorf began in 1847, with a small group of Silesian settlers, family plots of grapevines, and shared values of love, faith and hope. Those little vineyards helped lay the foundation for what the Barossa is today. Our Winemakers range honours the Krondorf legacy with these fresh and modern wines that exemplify what the Barossa region has to offer. This chardonnay is a fantastic introduction to a classic Eden Valley fruit-forward style, and delivers the hallmark brightness and freshness of the region.

Region

Eden Valley saw its first vines planted at Pewsey Vale in 1847. Early plantings of riesling, shiraz and cabernet soon thrived, and the region developed alongside the neighbouring Barossa Valley. Riesling is the most important white grape of the region, closely followed by chardonnay. Rocky, shallow soils prevalent in the region, coupled with the cooler conditions, make Eden Valley perfect for growing high-quality chardonnay.

Eden Valley sits 34 degrees south of the equator, at a similar latitude to the Barossa Valley. However, the higher elevation of Eden Valley provides cooler conditions, 5-7°C lower than the Barossa Valley floor. The undulating, hilly terrain provides a diverse range of sub-climates, meaning aspect and slope are important factors in vineyard site selection.

Tasting notes

Aromas of white peach and nectarine abound, while the palate brims with fresh stonefruit, spicy oak and a textured mouthfeel. Bright citrus lemon flavours on the finish.
